Policy Statement

The County of Vermilion River is committed to protecting County infrastructure, minimizing risk of damage, and sustaining a working relationship with County residents and line owners.

Purpose:

The purpose of this Policy is to establish a consistent standard for any company, authority or individual seeking to cross a County roadway.

Policy:

- 1. Line crossings include the transfer of materials such as water, power & produced products.
- 2. All costs associated with the installation of and future maintenance or relocation costs of the line crossing will be at the line grantee's s expense.
- 3. Line crossing developed roads shall all be bored at a minimum of 2.5 meters below ditch bottom and lines crossing undeveloped roads at a minimum of 1.5 meters below ditch bottom.
- 4. Grantees avoid line crossings on hills.
- 5. Open cut by Director of Public Works approval only.
- 6. All line crossing locations must be approved by the Director of Public Works by written agreement.

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
