Purpose:

The County of Vermilion River No. 24 wishes to establish a criterion to:

- 1. Deal with long range maintenance of its commuter roads on a County wide basis
- 2. Provide an understanding to the public regarding the benchmarks being used to identify, evaluate, determine project priorities
- 3. Give guidelines and levels of service while working through the budgeting process
- 4. Balance the fiscal and general taxation impacts to the ratepayers with the infrastructure concerns of the public
- 5. Projects are intended to last 5 years with minor repairs during the 5 years.

Guidelines/Standards:

- 1. Criteria for Identifying Commuter Roads
 - a. 100 plus traffic volumes,
 - b. condition of road,
 - c. residences using the road; and
 - d. networking.
 - (2 traffic counts are to be done each year for each road.)
- 2. Criteria for Laying New Oil on Commuter Roads
 - a. 100 plus traffic volumes,
 - b. No more than 10-15% truck volume,
 - c. costs will vary due to condition of road by testing of the road grade, which will be done to determine the cost; and
 - d. anticipation of increase of truck traffic will need to be taken into consideration.
