TULLIBY LAKE COMMUNITY PROFILE



The Hamlet of Tulliby Lake is located in Division 6 in the North East area of the County of Vermilion River. It is a small community of 22 residents (according to the 2015 County census).

Tulliby Lake is 34 km northeast of Marwayne, and 29 km northwest of Lloydminster, making it the northernmost community in the County.

COMMUNITY

- **Education**: students are bussed to Marwayne (K-12) school. The school is part of the Buffalo Trails School Division.
- Transportation: Tulliby Lake is accessed from either Highway 897 to Highway 641 from the west or north of Lloydminster on Highway 17 to Highway 641.
- Services: residents are serviced with natural gas infrastructure; and have road maintenance monitored and managed by the County. Fire and emergency services located nearby in Marwayne respond to 911 calls.
- Recreation: The Tulliby Lake Ag Society operates a community hall facility. Other recreation facilities can be found in Marwayne, which is home to community hall, playgrounds, agricultural society and indoor arena. In Lloydminster there is access to further recreation facilities such as swimming pools, ball diamonds, soccer fields, fitness centers, library, multi-plex and more.

BUSINESS & EMPLOYMENT

- Primary industry is agriculture, with a growth in oil and gas. The majority of residents will commute to work in Lloydminster, Marwayne or Kitscoty.
- Larger urban centers nearby include the City of Lloydminster and the Town of Vermilion. These centers are home to many more key service providers and potential employers/employees
- There is opportunity for development in the Hamlet and region for light commercial/industrial and residential
