STREAMSTOWN COMMUNITY PROFILE



The Hamlet of Streamstown is located in Division 5 in the North East area of the County of Vermilion River. It is a close-knit community of 20 residents (according to the 2015 County census).

Streamstown is 18 km north of Blackfoot, 19 km southeast of Marwayne, and 29 km northwest of Lloydminster.

COMMUNITY

- Education: students are bussed to Kitscoty Elementary (K-6) and Kitscoty Junior/Senior High (7-12) schools where there are approximately 259 elementary students and 240 students in grades 7-12. The schools are part of the Buffalo Trails School Division.
- > **Transportation:** Streamstown is accessed from either Highway 897 to township 514 from the west or north of Blackfoot on Range Road 21 to township road 514.
- Services: residents are serviced with natural gas infrastructure; and have road maintenance monitored and managed by the County. Fire and emergency services located nearby in Marwayne respond to 911 calls.
- Recreation: The closest recreation facilities can be found in Marwayne or Kitscoty which are home to community halls, playgrounds, ag society and indoor arenas. In Lloydminster there is access to further recreation facilities such as swimming pools, ball diamonds, soccer fields, fitness centers, library, multi-plex and more.

BUSINESS & EMPLOYMENT

- Primary industry is agriculture, with a growth in oil and gas. The majority of residents will commute to work in Lloydminster, Marwayne or Kitscoty.
- Larger urban centers nearby include the City of Lloydminster and the Town of Vermilion. These centers are home to many more key service providers and potential employers/employees
- There is opportunity for development in the Hamlet and region for light commercial/industrial and residential
